



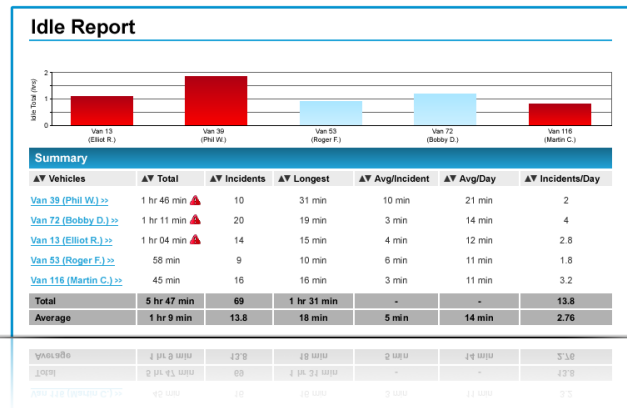
Idle Report

Track costly vehicle idling events with exception reporting, analytics and more

Navtrak's Idle Report makes it easy to view the length and frequency of idling events within your fleet whenever you need to. By simply selecting the time frame, vehicles and idle exceptions you'd like to know about, the Idle Report will return a summary of each idle event with the option to drill down for more specific information. Each idle event reported is labeled by the location, address or point name as identified in your Navtrak interface.

Features

- Multiple ways to analyze fleet data: summary view (*whole fleet*), detailed view (*individual vehicles*) and analytic view (*graphs*)
- Filter idling events by vehicle, date, minimum idle time and total fleet idle time
- Drill down to view detailed activity report for vehicles in violation
- Display total fleet idle time, average vehicle idle time and individual idle times
- Display number and location of all violations as they occurred



Navtrak's Idle Report shows you your entire fleet's idling activity at a glance, and allows you to drill down to learn more about a specific vehicle/idling event.

Business applications

- **Measure and monitor fuel costs** – Since a half-gallon of fuel is burned for every hour spent idling, this report can be used to calculate how much fuel your fleet is wasting due to excess idling.
- **Analyze environmental impact of your fleet** – Shine a light on the carbon emissions your fleet is releasing back into the air by tallying up the hours they spend idling.
- **Monitor job performance of your drivers** – If you've got standards regarding how much drivers should be idling, this report allows you to immediately identify violators.
- **Manage excessive wear and tear on your vehicles** – Excess idling accelerates the wear and tear of any vehicle engine. The information presented here makes it easy for you to eliminate wasteful practices to help keep your trucks on the road.
